

How to deal with ...

Yellow warning triangle

Type: “Long time since last update”, **Country:** “Switzerland”, “SEARCH”

Mail: “Outdated pad on helipad.org”

Yellow warning triangles appear when a pad has not been updated for over a year. If the base concerned fails to take action, it will receive weekly reminders requesting it to check and amend the information published.

Log in (“admin”, required pad, “edit pad”) and check – if necessary, by means of a telephone enquiry – whether the details (including the telephone numbers!) are still correct. When the checking/correction procedure has been completed, press “save”.

The yellow warning triangle will disappear and no more reminders will be sent.

Mail: “Outdated comment on helipad.org”

Six months after a comment has been added to the pad, a weekly reminder is sent with a request to check the contents. If the base concerned fails to take action, it will receive weekly reminders requesting it to check and amend the information published.

Log in (“admin”, required pad, “edit comment”) and check – if necessary by means of a telephone enquiry – whether the comment is still correct. When the checking/correction procedure has been completed, press “save only”. No more reminders will be sent for the next six months.

Permanent obstacles

Please note that you must enter details of permanent obstacles in the pad. Entries listed under “permanent obstacles” are an integral part of the pad; reminders relating solely to this information will not be sent.

Webcams

The addresses of the Webcams (URL) are checked weekly by the system to ensure that they are up-to-date. If an address is no longer in operation, or no longer provides access to the desired Webcam, the base concerned will be requested by means of weekly reminders to search for a / the new link

Log in (“admin”, required pad, “edit pad”) and add the new link (URL). When the checking/correction procedure has been completed, press “save”. No more reminders will be sent.
